INSURANCE/SECURITY:

Insurance is the sole responsibility of the entrant. SVQT will handle your entries with great care with all the exhibit halls locked during the night hours. The quilts will be monitored by hosts and white glove volunteers during business hours.

QUILT DELIVERY FOR SHOW:

Deliver your prepared (sleeve attached) quilt along with completed paperwork and appropriate fee for each entry on **Friday, August 13, 2021**, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. at the Thayne Community Center, 250 Vanoy Parkway, Thayne WY.

Mail your prepared (sleeve attached) quilt to arrive by August 13, 2021, along with a copy of the completed paperwork and appropriate fee for each entry. Mailing instructions will be on your confirmation acceptance email.

Each entry should be in a pillowcase labeled with the entry number, your name, name of quilt, and phone number during the event. Quilts without pillowcases will be put in plastic bags. Quilts rolled or in tubes will also be accepted.

QUILT RETURN AFTER SHOW:

Quilts may be picked up at the end of the show Saturday August, 21, 2021, starting at 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. at the location where the quilt(s) is on display. If you are unable to pick up your quilt(s) at that time, you may pick them up on **Monday, August 23, 2021**, at the Thayne Community Center, 250 Vanoy Parkway, Thayne WY, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Please ensure the person picking up your quilt(s) has the **Claim Check** below for that quilt or we will not be able to release it. If your quilt was mailed, it will be mailed back to you the week following the show. If your quilt was mailed but you intend to physically pick it up after the show, please advise the SVQT and bring a **Claim Check** per quilt being picked up.

- Quilt entry fee is \$5.00 for each quilt entered. Youth entries are FREE (age 16 and under). Fees are submitted with your quilt after receiving mailing instructions.
- Quilt entries are limited to three (3) quilts per person. Please prioritize your quilts if you are entering more than one (1) quilt. If we must limit the number of entries, determine the order you want your quilts to be considered for the show.
- Complete an entry form for each quilt entered.
- Include a 4 x 6 photo of each quilt with your name, address and quilt name on the back
- Entry Form and quilt photo, for each quilt entered, must be received by July 25, 2021, to be considered for the show. Keep a copy of your Entry Form for your records. Mailing instructions are on the Entry Form, Page 3.
- SVQT will send you a confirmation acceptance email. Be sure our email is in your contact list.
- Accepted quilts and entry fees must be received by August 13, 2021. Instructions for mailing your quilt will be in your confirmation acceptance email. In person quilt delivery can be found on the Entry Form, Page 2.
- Unfinished quilts will not be accepted.
- All entries, regardless of size (except for miniatures), must have a 4" wide sleeve sewn the entire width of the back-top edge of the quilt. For quilts longer than 105", the top edge of the sleeve must be 100 inches up from the bottom of quilt (maximum hanging length). See *Hanging Sleeve Instructions* on the SVQT website.
- If your quilt will be mailed in, include a pre-paid return label with each box.
- Insurance is the sole responsibility of the entrant. Star Valley Quilt Trail assumes no liability for the entries. SVQT will handle your quilt(s) with great care and all exhibit halls will be locked during the overnight hours with hosts in the exhibit hall during business hours.
- In the interest of preserving the history of today's quilts, quilts must have an identifying label securely attached to the back of the quilt; who made the quilt, title, when, where.
- Entries accepted and displayed are at the discretion of the Quilt Show Committee. The Committee also reserves the right to recategorize any entry.

Categories – *Perimeter is the total inches of all four sides added together*

- Star Valley Quilt Trail Challenge 2021 Theme: *Wonderful Wild West*** - maximum size 42" X 42" or perimeter* of 168 inches. May be any shape or technique.
- Wall Hanging** – quilts that are intended to be hung on a wall or displayed as ornamentation or decoration. Quilts in this category may be traditional or novelty in design and construction and may be pieced and/or appliqued. Perimeter must be greater than 96 inches.
- Traditional Pieced** - based on traditional patterns and settings. This category includes historic reproduction or vintage quilts. May be any technique and any size.
- Contemporary Pieced** - creative deviation from traditional patterns and settings. To reflect a contemporary rather than historic aesthetic. May be any technique and any size.
- Applique** – must be predominantly applique (50% or more) by either hand or machine and may be any size.
- Mixed Technique** - a quilt that includes a balanced variety of techniques i.e. applique, pieced, trapunto, surface designs or embellishments, hand/machine embroidery; and may be any size.
- Holiday** - a quilt for any holiday and may be any technique and any size.
- Group** – a quilt where 3 or more people were involved in the design, construction, quilting, and finishing of the quilt. May be any technique and any size.
- Art / Innovative** – quilts will be judged for their artistic merit and design. May be any technique and any size.
- Miniature** - a quilt in this category will have overall pattern(s) that show reduced scale and miniaturization with a maximum perimeter of 96 inches; may be any technique.
- Youth** - judged by age group 5-7, 8-10, 11-13 and 14-16. May be any technique and any size.
